We recommended
women have a breast
screen every two
years.



1 in 7 women in NSW will **develop breast cancer**.
9 out of 10 women with breast cancer have
no family history.

If found early, breast cancer is easier to treat and there is an
increased chance of survival.

Women aged 40 - 49 and over 74 are also welcome to attend. However, speak to your doctor first to see if screening is a right for you.
