Students will develop skills to learn how to appeal a decision for involuntary treatment and how to request a meeting with an Official Visitor.

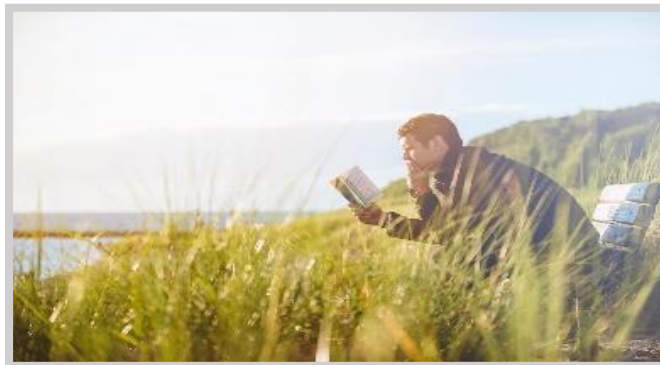
