We don't stop at case management. We also offer one-on-one youth counselling to help you address your Alcohol and other Drug use, as well as your mental health. A holistic approach to your individual circumstances will really help improve your outcomes and recovery.

Our youth counsellor and group facilitator will be able to offer targeted early intervention and prevention programs. This could be in groups, one-to-one, at your school, or in the community.
