Eligibility

Parent Pathways is available to parents and carers who have a child aged under 6, and are not in paid employment.

To be eligible you must also be:

Receiving a Parenting or Carers Payment or Special Benefit,
OR

Not receiving a Payment but are either:

- * Aged under 22, or
- * A First Nations parent or carer, or
- * An early school leaver (do not hold a Year 12 or higher qualification)
