Course description:

This skill set is aimed at individuals wanting to enter the hair industry to provide hair styling services for special occasions.

Under the guidance of an industry experienced facilitator, you will gain hands on practical skills and knowledge to provide pre-service shampoos and treatments, and post treatment removal of residual colour and lightening products, dry hair to shape after services using a variety of styling tools, complete full or partial braiding finishes to hair, and provide exceptional customer service.

In addition to braiding hair, you will consult with clients and analyse hair and facial characteristics to design, recommend and complete a range of complementary up-styles for long hair. This includes braids, twists, classic rolls and chignons.

Uniform requirements:

It is a Work, Health and Safety requirement in the salon that you **MUST** wear fully enclosed shoes, black long pants or knee length skirt, and black sleeved (long or short) shirt.

Career opportunities:

Hair stylist, salon assistant. On successful completion of the six (6) units of study, you may gain credit towards the *Certificate III in Hairdressing (SHB30416)*.
