Course description:

This skill set is aimed at individuals wanting to enter the beauty industry as a beautician, focusing on lash and brow services.

Under the guidance of an industry experienced facilitator, you will gain hands on practical skills and knowledge to provide lash and brow services that include shaping and colouring.

Learn how to consult with clients on treatment, cleanse eye area and eyebrows to thoroughly remove eye make-up, select suitable products and equipment, test wax temperature, apply and remove wax using single use applicators to shape eyebrows, ensure all wax is removed from the skin, use tweezers to finalise eyebrow shape, seek feedback from client, provide aftercare advice and recommend products and future treatments, and clean service area and equipment.

Maintaining professionalism in the salon is essential. Having the willingness to work with a variety of clients, being comfortable close to a client, following strict hygiene and work, health and safety principles, and being time efficient. Students will put their skills to the test and experience the real world, by providing beauty treatments to paying clients in our on campus simulated beauty salon.
