Have you heard of Childhood Apraxia of Speech?

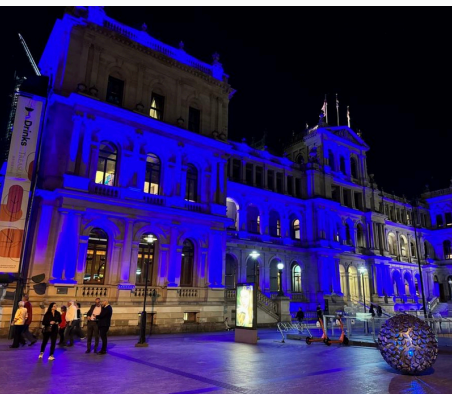
A lifelong, neurological, speech disorder affecting 1-2 in 1000 children.

This makes their speech hard to understand.
