SPECIALIST LGBTIQA+ PRACTICE TRAINING FOR HEALTH WORKERS



Prism in Practice is a free, half day training session for health workers and clinicians supporting LGBTIQA+ young people. The training will cover best practice guidance across the following key practice areas:

- LGBTIQA+ CALD young people
- LGBTIQA+ young people from religious backgrounds
- LGBTIQA+ young people in regional and rural communities
- LGBTIQA+ young people experiencing suicidality
- Supporting Parents of LGBTIQA+ young people
- Supporting Dads of LGBTIQA+ young people

Building on Safe & Affirmed, Twenty10's previous specialist training for CAMHS workers, this training upskills participants to provide affirming and inclusive early intervention and preventative care.

This training is suitable for clinicians and health workers supporting LGBTIQA+ young people across health settings, including mental health, drug and alcohol, nursing, community health and others.
