Who should apply?

Community organisations or social enterprises seeking student support on projects such as:

- design, branding and digital assets
- marketing, communications, storytelling, social media
- customer or market research
- organisational change and strategic planning

- complex social issue research and proposals (First Nations organisations preferred), with an engineering lens
- research reports (including policy, literature reviews and program evaluation)
- survey design, data analysis, evaluation and evidence-based communications, informed by human behaviour
- sustainability projects requiring program evaluation or hands-on support
- software solutions, engineering and product development (including the creation of minimum viable products and prototypes)

Whether you have a fully scoped idea or a broader idea for a project, we encourage you to submit a proposal. Our Shopfront team can help you refine your idea.
